SCOPE

The 7th International Symposium on Research in High Magnetic Fields will take place in Toulouse (France) from July 20th to July 23rd 2003, organised by the Laboratoire National des Champs Magnétiques Pulsés. It is a satellite of the International Conference on Magnetism ICM 2003, organised in Rome from July 27th to August 1st 2003, and succeeds symposia in Porto (2000), Sydney (1997), Nijmegen (1994), Amsterdam (1991), Leuven (1988) and Osaka (1982).

The Symposium aims to cover recent highlights in research in high magnetic fields, in areas like magnetism, magneto-transport and magneto-optics of condensed and dilute matter, developments in high magnetic field generation and new high magnetic field measurement techniques.

LOCATION

The symposium will be held on the campus of the Institut National des Sciences Appliquées (www.insa-tlse.fr) in Toulouse. Toulouse, also known as « la Ville Rose », is a lively city in the South-West of France, with a pleasant climate, very good food and friendly inhabitants (www.mairie-toulouse.fr).

Conference participants will receive an abstract booklet at the registration desk. Papers will be refereed during the conference and published as a regular issue of Physica B (North-Holland).
